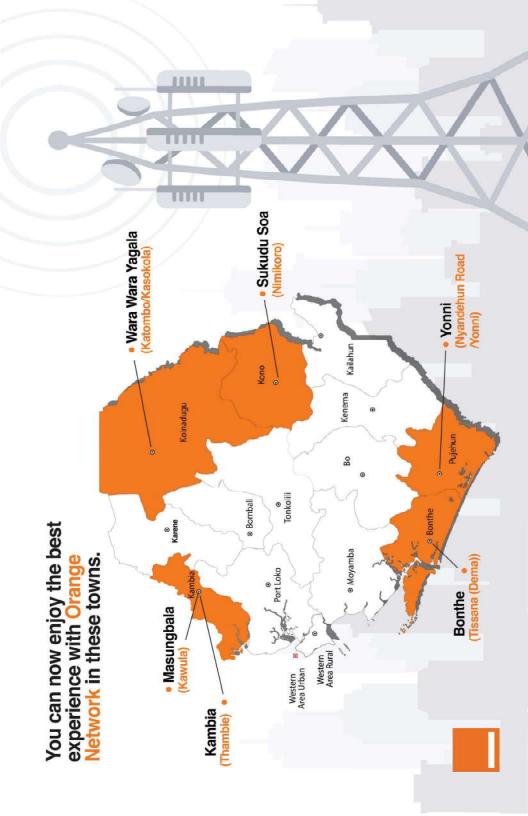

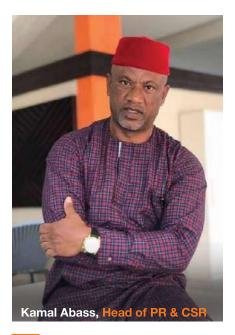

lack of essentials, we help to provide access to education, healthcare and promote culture for those in our society who would not otherwise have access, not to mention the socially excluded and unemployed."





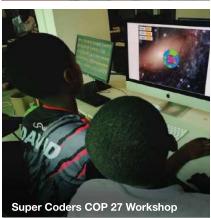

Digital Centre

Digital training to empower women without qualifications

WDC is a digital and entrepreneurial educational Group project that kicked off in 2021 in Sierra Leone with NAYCOM as our Implementing Partner. It is designed for vulnerable Women, inclusive of drop out Girls & semi-Literate Women. We trained them on ICT; Life Skills; Personal Competency; Entrepreneurship & Business Plan Development Training; Transformational Leadership; Communication Skills; Interpersonal Skills and Conflict Resolution.

126 Vulnerable Women have graduated from the 1st Cohort while 146 is presently undergoing similar training. Such training brings immense potential to improve social and economic outcomes for women in Sierra Leone by enabling them



to be more informed by being digitally literate. They become more aware by having access to the internet and this information leads to women making more informed choices in life and motivates them each day to learn something new and develop new skills and interests.







Early Childhood **Development Schools**

Children in rural areas benefitting from structured early childhood curriculum



2018, Orange SL pledged to support the Government in their Flagship Free Quality Education project. The Foundation partnership with the Ministry of Basic & Senior Secondary Education. has constructed five ultra-modern Early Childhood Development Schools in the provinces 4 of which has been successfully launched in Kenema, Pujehun, Kambia and Port Loko respectively. "

86.5% (1730/2000) households in Kroobay community sensitized

125 (41.7) of the 300 project target women linked to healthcare facilities

355 community members screened: HIV = 21/355 (5.9%) Blood sugar =55/355 (15.4%) Malaria = 31/355 (8.7%) Anemia = 45/355 (12.6%)
